## **PRESS RELEASE**

For Immediate Release 01/13/12

At approximately 2:31 A.M. Carver Police Dispatch received a 911 call reporting a motor vehicle accident at the intersection of High and Gate Streets. Officers were immediately dispatched and arrived on scene shortly thereafter.

Upon arrival, the Officers discovered a 1982 Ford F150 truck that had impacted against a large tree and sustained substantial damage. Upon inspecting the vehicle and the surrounding area, it was obvious that the operator had left the scene.

Since a significant quantity of blood was discovered there was a concern that the operator, perhaps seriously injured, may have wandered off into the woods or bogs. Consequently, a K9 unit was summonsed to assist in a more extensive search. In response, both a State Police K9 unit and a Plymouth County Sheriff's K9 unit arrived to assist.

Prior to initiating a search for the operator, subsequently identified as Daniel Labossiere, age 28, of Gilead, ME and formerly of Carver, Mr. Labossiere returned to the scene, assisted by his wife. The couple had been visiting with relatives a short distance from the scene, and Mr. Labossiere had gone to seek assistance.

After viewing Mr. Labossiere's physical condition, the officer's determined that he required medical treatment and called for Carver EMS. He was subsequently transported to South Shore Hospital where his condition is unknown at this time.

Meanwhile, Mr. Labossiere's vehicle was towed and the officers cleared the scene. The investigation remains open and ongoing at this time.
