Massachusetts drivers and passengers were sent the message earlier last month that they should always wear their seat belts or be ready to face the consequences. During the third special statewide *Click It or Ticket* enforcement mobilization this year, Carver Police Officers were out in force checking to make sure anyone pulled over for disobeying traffic laws were wearing their seat belts.

The Carver Police Department is one of over 100 departments statewide to partner with the State Police and adopt a zero tolerance policy on belt violations. Over 20 citations were issued and along with 6 criminal citations. Officers also conducted a seat belt usage survey. Seventy Six percent of the motorists observed during the survey were wearing their seatbelts. Regular seat belt use is the single most effective way to protect people and reduce fatalities in motor vehicle crashes. Motorists are reminded to “Click it or Ticket”.
